## TNR (trap-neuter-return) Services for Franklin County, KY Cats

The Franklin County Humane Society (FCHS) offers Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) clinics for Franklin County, KY residents only. TNR clinics are for outdoor community cats--feral, free-roaming, and stray cats in Frankfort and Franklin County. All cats are returned to their home location.

All cats must arrive in live traps. This is for the safety of the cats, staff and volunteers. Traps can be provided for trapping and transporting. Cats receive their spay/neuter surgery, vaccinations for rabies and FVRCP (for feline upper respiratory viruses), and a flea-tick preventative good for 30 days. All cats will be ear-tipped (left ear). No exceptions. Ear-tipping is done under anesthesia, at the time of surgery.

TNR is supported with fund-raising activities, grants, personal donations, and FCHS funds. There is no fee required. A \$15/cat donation is suggested if you are able to contribute to this work.
